Agenda Item 2: General Updates

After Roll Call, a brief review of the Agenda and Housekeeping, Madame Chair Bailey-Crimmins introduced Jacob Virges, who gave a spoken word poem on the digital divide.

Agenda Item 3: General Updates

Scott Adams provided the background for and goals of Broadband for All and the State Digital Equity Plan. Scott then discussed the accomplishments SDEP has had to date. No questions were asked by members of the Statewide Planning Group (SPG).

Commissioner Darcie Houck provided an update on Broadband Equity, Access, and Deployment (<u>BEAD</u>) <u>program</u> with a timeline through 2025. Sunne McPeak asked questions about the State's constrictions on maps.

Agenda Item 4: NTIA Comments and Updates

Gladys Palpallatoc discussed the upcoming opportunity to participate in and comment on the State Digital Equity Plan. She also discussed the engagement from Tribal communities on the plan. She then provided an update on the NOFO for the capacity grant expected in 2024. There were no questions.

Agenda Item 5: State Digital Equity (and BEAD) Planning Process Update

Scott Adams provided an update on the State Digital Equity Planning approach, accomplishment to date, and scope of engagement. He followed up by discussing the different Digital Equity and BEAD regional workshops held throughout the State between April and July. A highlight video of the San Joaquin Valley Broadband for All, Digital Equity, and BEAD Planning workshop was shown. Scott followed that by sharing high level summaries of barriers faced by covered populations and the recommended strategies to overcome these barriers gathered from all planning processes. At this point, Scott handed the presentation over to Sunne McPeak for an update on the phone survey, and then to Rachna Vas for an update on the online survey and DEEM tool. Lastly, Scott tasked Sandra Levy from Runyon Saltzman to discuss the stakeholder

engagement process and outcomes, including the partnership outreach toolkits developed to help stakeholders engaged their community members in the planning process and media impact.

Scott Adams concluded by discussing the next steps for the State Digital Equity Plan. He handed the mic to Maria Ellis, Deputy Director for Broadband from CPUC, to discuss the BEAD's timeline and next steps through 2024.
