





## 3. Spotlight

On August 12, the California Department of Technology attended a ribbon-cutting ceremony in Hoopa, hosted by the Hoopa Valley Tribe and Hoopa Valley Public Utilities District. The event marked the start of construction of nearly 23 miles of middle-mile fiber along State Route 96, through the Tribe's ancestral land. This joint-build partnership will help provide broadband internet access to one of California's largest and most remote tribal communities.
